Waste for incineration
(subject to charges)

- Household waste like: packaging material, plastic products, cat litter, etc.
- Bulky goods such as: Skis, detergent boxes, carpets, furniture, mattresses, etc.

Waste for composting
(subject to charges)

- Only in standard containers (140 – 770 liter / comb lifting systems)
- Leftovers (no bones), Leaves, grass, grass clippings, garden waste, peels, coffee grounds, hedge trimmings, balcony and pot plants (no potting soil)
- Branch material and shrubs shall be cut into bundles of max. 1.5m in length, 50cm in diameter and max. 20kg.
- From October to March pure leaf waste can be provided in open, easy to empty containers of max. 20kg (free of charge), for example baskets, buckets, plastic bags with handles. No plastic bags without handles, no plastic drums, etc.
- Christmas trees can be disposed free of charge
- FORBIDDEN: plastic and other non-degradable garbage



Paper (free)

- Newspapers, books, envelopes, cardboard, folded boxes (without polystyrene- and plastic material, no detergent boxes), provide tied in a pile or in containers

Metal (free)

- Cans, pans, bicycles, metal fences, etc. (incl. tinplate and aluminum products)

Disposal site (free)

- Stones, bricks, flower pots, concrete and asbestos cement, ceramics, flat glass such as window panes and mirrors

Glas (free)

- Disposable containers such as bottles, vials, jam-, honey and other food jars

Waste collection for special types of waste

The following waste and scrap material can be disposed of at the communal waste collection point:

- Hazardous waste (small quantities from households, such as paints & varnishes, solvents, oils & fats, pesticides) (subject to charges)
- Tires with and without wheels (subject to charges)
- Car batteries (subject to charges)
- Cooking and motor oil (free for small quantities from households)
- Electrical and electronic equipment from the office, home, garden (free)
- Luminaires and lamps (neon tubes, light bulbs, etc.) (free)
- Small batteries and rechargeable batteries (free)
- Nespresso capsules (free)
- PET (free)
- Iron, metals, tin cans and aluminum products (for free)
- Natural corks (free)
- Paper and cardboard (free)
- Glass, bottles, food jars (free)
- Disposal site (clay pots, ceramics, stones, mirrors, etc.) (free for small quantities)
- Waste for incineration (subject to charges)
- Waste for composting (subject to charges)
- Old clothing collection (free)

Waste disposal charges

The disposal waste must be provided according to their volume with fee stamps. Garbage fee stamps up to 110 liters are available in all grocery stores and the Shell station in Muri. Further, 140-240 liters single fee stamps for composting are available at Migros in Gümligen and Egghölzli, at Coop in Muri and Gümligen and at Denner. All fee stamps, incl. annual fee stamps for composting, may also be obtained from the Municipal Administration in Muri, 2nd floor (pay office). For the 17 liters bag there are no fee stamps available. As a replacement, half a fee stamp of the 35 liters bag may be used.
